

Rules for applying for an IESE Fellowship

1. Acceptance Criteria:

The fellowship is open to full-time editorial employees of newspapers, magazines, wire services and broadcast news organizations. Candidates will be evaluated based on their work experience, statement of purpose, recommendations from their supervisors and work samples.

Candidates work should demonstrate high standards of journalism, ethics and responsibility in the media. In line with IESE's mission, the school will favor journalistic works which have helped promote ethical business practices, signal or amend situations of social unfairness, etc.

Financial Aid

The fellowships are granted by IESE Business School and cover 80 percent of the academic fees of the program the journalist chooses to apply to.

2. Application Process:

Eligible candidates should send their applications and required documentation to: iesefellowship@iese.edu by May 25, 2020.

Together with the application form, candidates should send:

- a. Letter from their boss expressing his/her support and granting the time required to participate in the program.
- b. Resumé.
- c. Essay explaining why they want to participate in the program (600 words).
- d. Three to five samples of their work (texts, videos, info graphics or audios.) For journalists whose native language is not English or Spanish, they should present the samples of their work in their original language as well as a copy in either English or Spanish.

3. Eligibility:

- a. At least 10 years of writing/broadcast experience with a significant media outlet.
- b. Excellent journalistic standards (trustworthy reporting).
- c. An advantage but not necessary:
 - Lead a team.
 - Write / Broadcast mainly about business, economics and finance topics.
 - Write / Broadcast in a media outlet with international exposure.

- Written / Video / Audio work which supports IESE's mission to have a positive impact in society.

4. Application Period:

- IESE will assess all the applications sent to the indicated email by May 25, 2020 (inclusive).
- The successful applicants will be informed before July 31, 2020.
